We believe this permit should receive special attention by the Air Pollution Control Board as best expressed at the November 9th public hearing by Park Superintendent Martha Boyle who advised that air quality is the biggest problem threatening the park. Hazy views diminish visitors' experience and acid rain harms the Parks streams and forests. Air pollution has already dramatically limited visibility from the park, down to an average of only 25 miles, where once people could see for more than 100 miles.
