Greetings, Ms. Riggleman,

I hereby request a review of the proposal to double the size of Dominion Virginia Power's proposed Natural gas power plant in Front Royal, which has never yet been built in the original smaller size which was approved in 2003.

Park Superintendent Martha Boyle says that air quality is the biggest problem threatening Shenandoah National Park, a local as well as national treasure. The gas plant would be built close to the SNP. It is critical to incorporate the recommendations from the National Park Service into any new permit. Already the Park Service is negotiating with Dominion on new carbon offsets to address the impact of this plant.

Additionally, I would hope the DEQ would solicit comments from other state agencies tasked with protecting scenic and historic resources to address the impact of three 175- foot smokestacks, onsite transmission facilities up to 160 feet, an auxiliary boiler stack up to 155 feet, an air cooled condenser up to 145 feet, and a heat recovery steam generator up to 120 feet.
