


Coastal Virginia Ecological Value Assessment (VEVA)

The Coastal Virginia Ecological Value Assessment (VEVA) was developed to provide guidance for land use management and conservation planning in Virginia's Coastal Zone. VEVA is a collaborative effort among several state programs to synthesize the best available natural resource information into a single geospatial product. VEVA combines scientific data and best professional judgment to rank terrestrial and aquatic areas for their ecological value.
