Dear Mr. Stewart:

On June 18, 2015, the Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) Office of Waste Permitting and Compliance (OWPC) received your submittal of the revised Part B permit application sections, dated June 16, 2015. The revised Part A and Part B application sections were submitted in response to the application completeness review notice of deficiency, dated May 18, 2015. Review of this information will commence and you will receive DEQ's comments within 30 days.

The DEQ has also received the extension requests for Tier 1 and Tier 2 items as identified by the *Summary of Specific NOD Discussions and Action Items (NOD Items)* table. The Tier 1 and 2 items were requested to be submitted 60 and 90 days, respectively, from the date of submittal of the NOD Items table. The request has been approved and the revised submittal dates for Tier 1 and 2 items will now be August 17, 2015, for Tier 1 items, and September 16, 2015 for Tier 2 items.

Additionally RAAP has included action items in the NOD Items table requesting the review of the RCRA regulations against the submitted contingency plan in lieu of submitting the Spill Control and Containment, Disaster Control and Plant Protection Plans as requested by the previous NOD's. DEQ will review the submitted contingency plan against the RCRA regulations and provide an itemized list of any technical deficiencies, if found within 30 days for RAAP to address with additional permit language in lieu of providing DEQ with the requested plans which were previously incorporated by reference.
