
Dear Ms. Romanchik:

Per receipt of your March 20, 2015 correspondence that included your 2nd round of deficiencies for the RFAAP Incinerator Permit application and is currently due to VADEQ on April 19th, 2015, which is a Sunday. We request an additional 30 days to conduct additional research and formulate our responses. The new response deadline will now be May 19, 2015.

Note per the April 14, 2015 conversation between Mr. Justin Williams and myself, we will remove language in the permit application concerning material at the Dublin facility being brought to Radford for disposal. The Dublin facility (NRU) currently holds a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator ID number and we will handle all hazardous wastes that may be generated at the NRU as required by regulations.
