STATE WATER CONTROL BOARD ENFORCEMENT ACTION AMENDMENT TO SPECIAL ORDER BY CONSENT ISSUED TO SAINT PAUL'S COLLEGE

SECTION A: Purpose

This is an Amendment to a Consent Special Order (hereinafter referred to as the Amendment) issued under the authority of Va. Code §62.1-44.15(8a) by the State Water Control Board to St. Paul's College, for the purpose of revising certain provisions of that Consent Special Order (hereinafter referred to as the Order) issued by the State Water Control Board to St. Paul's College on March 24, 2004.


SECTION B: Basis for Amendment

1. St. Paul's College owns and operates a sewage collection system in Lawrenceville, Virginia.
2. The Order issued to St. Paul's College on March 24, 2004, required the College to secure federal funding and begin construction on a sewer rehabilitation project by October 1, 2005.
3. Funding was secured and the project went to bid, however all the bids were higher than the money granted. This was mainly due to the significant increase in the price of sewer pipe since the Order was issued. Several attempts were made to adjust the scope of the project so that enough funds were available for partial construction.
4. The College met with the Department on May 4, 2006, and requested a one year extension to re-bid and construct the project.

SECTION D: Agreement and Order


Accordingly, the State Water Control Board, by virtue of the authority granted it in §62.1-44.15(8a), orders St. Paul's College and St. Paul's College agrees to perform the actions described in Appendix A of this Amendment, which supercedes Appendix A of the Order. Both the State Water Control Board and St. Paul's College understand and agree that this Amendment does not alter, modify, or amend any other provision of the Order and that unmodified provisions of the Order remain in effect by their own terms.



APPENDIX A

St. Paul's College shall:

1. Visually inspect its sewer lines and manholes weekly, remove roots around obstructed manholes and lines within 3 days of discovery, and clean the lines as necessary within 7 days of discovering a problem. A log of these actions shall be maintained at the college and made available to the Department upon request.
2. On or before October 1, 2007, complete construction of the sewer rehabilitation project in accordance with the plans and specifications approved by the Department..
3. Submit quarterly reports to the Department starting on October 1, 2006, detailing the progress made on the rehabilitation project. Reports are to be submitted no later than the 10th of the month due, until the project has been completed.
