Summary:

This guidance updates and supersedes Chapter 2A of the DEQ Civil Enforcement Manual (May 11, 2012). The following documents have been added as attachments in Chapter 2A:

- 2-2E Model Warning Letter – Construction Stormwater
- 2-4F Model NOV – Construction Stormwater
- 2-15L Model Consent Order – Construction Stormwater

This guidance also repeals the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board and Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation Stormwater Enforcement Manual (DCR – VSWCB – 012) (February 2006), except for Attachment 6 of that manual. Attachment 6 is being separately continued today as part of Chapter 4 of the DEQ Civil Enforcement Manual, pending public notice and comment on revised procedures for calculating appropriate civil charges or civil penalties in Virginia Stormwater Management Program (VSMP) cases. See [2013 Acts c. 756 cl. 13](#). DEQ Enforcement of the VSMP will follow the applicable statutes and regulations and the DEQ Civil Enforcement Manual, including the documents added here.
