

PUBLIC NOTICE
WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD
VIRGINIA VOLUNTARY REMEDIATION PROGRAM

CNA Holdings LLC and Clariant Corporation, the Participants, have requested from the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (“DEQ”) a Certificate of Satisfactory Completion of Remediation for property located at 3340 W. Norfolk Rd., Portsmouth, VA (the “Site”). An environmental investigation revealed contaminated soil and groundwater at the Site associated with historical industrial operations. Impacted soil has been removed or capped in portions of the Site, and remedial activities have occurred in former wastewater lagoons. Engineering and land use controls are proposed to (i) prohibit use of the Site for residential purposes, (ii) prohibit use of groundwater beneath the Site for potable purposes, (iii) impose requirements to protect workers during excavation activities, (iv) impose requirements to assess for any potential indoor air vapor intrusion prior to any future construction at the Site, and (v) if the existing aggregate cap installed at the Site is disturbed, require restoration of the cap or the installation of an alternate but equally protective cap. DEQ has proposed issuance of the requested Certificate. Written comments on DEQ’s proposed action will be received for 30 days following publication of this notice and should be sent to:
