COMPOSTING

YES ALL FOOD, FOOD-SOILED PAPER (UNCOATED), COMPOSTIBLE PACKAGING AND CONTAINERS


NO NON-COMPOSTABLE UTENSILS, FOOD WRAPPERS

OTHER RECYCLABLES - COLLECTED SEPARATELY

YES PLASTIC BAGS, CARDBOARD BOXES, PALLETS, COOKING OILS/GRASES

NO BAGS WITH FOOD DEBRIS, SAFARI WRAP, FOOD RELATED FOAM

TRASH/GARBAGE
This is where everything NOT identified as OK to recycle or compost should go. Recyclable items that are not cleaned of food debris are trash. Styrofoam, containers from outside the event, plastic straws and food wrappers.
