

Piedmont Geriatric Hospital Aspects and Impacts Procedure

On March 16, 2011, Piedmont Geriatric Hospital's (PGH) Environmental Management Systems Management Team consisting of representatives from the offices of the Director of Administration, Environmental Services Manager, Grounds Supervisor, Safety Officer, Procurement Officer, & Work Order Manager, re-evaluated the existing Environmental Policy Statement and review of environmental aspects and impacts (A/I Matrix). It was deemed to be appropriate.

Using the values established in the A/I matrix, fuel combustion was ranked the highest. The EMS Management Team selected fuel combustion as "significant" based on the highest ranking and developed Objectives and Targets to reflect a fuel combustion reduction goal.

PGH will continue reviewing the progress of the EMS program quarterly, and conduct a review and re-evaluation of the Aspects and Impacts annually. The results of the review/re-evaluation will be presented for annual management review to consider adjustments as necessary.
