

Public Notice – Environmental Permit

PURPOSE OF NOTICE: To seek public comment on a draft permit from the Department of Environmental Quality for the withdrawal of ground water in Accomack County, Virginia.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: November 9, 2013 to December 9, 2013

PERMIT NAME: Ground Water Withdrawal Permit issued by DEQ, under the authority of the State Water Control Board

NAME AND LOCATION OF WATER WITHDRAWAL: Virginia Landing; 40226 Upshur Neck Rd., Quinby, VA 23423

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: MHC NAC Inc has applied for a reissuance of a permit for the Virginia Landing Campground in Accomack County, Virginia. The permit would allow the applicant to withdraw an average of 16,438 gallons per day. The ground water withdrawal will support the campground facilities which include both seasonal and year round lots. The proposed withdrawal will utilize the Upper Yorktown-Eastover aquifer at a depth between 140 feet to 171 feet below the land surface at the withdrawal site. An aquifer is a body of rock or layer of sediment in the ground in which ground water is stored and transported. DEQ has made a tentative decision to issue the permit.

AFFECTED AREA: The radial distance from the well(s) to where computer modeling predicts the aquifer(s) may experience one foot of drawdown due to the withdrawal does not extend beyond the applicant's property.

HOW TO COMMENT AND OR REQUEST A PUBLIC HEARING: DEQ accepts comments and requests for public hearing by e-mail, fax or postal mail. All comments and requests must be in writing and be received by DEQ during the comment period. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of the commenter/requester and of all persons represented by the commenter/requester. A request for public hearing must also include: 1) The reason why a public hearing is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. DEQ may hold a public hearing, including another comment period, if public response is significant and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the proposed permit.
