All CVS, Walgreens, Rite-Aide and Kroger pharmacies now sell postage-paid envelopes for around \$3.99 that you can mail your unwanted medications to Sharp Compliance in Texas for disposal. With the exception of chemo drugs, all medications can be disposed of this way. Check this site <http://www.disposemy meds.org/> for pharmacies that accept medications for disposal. In many cases, they will only accept non-controlled substances unless they have a Drug Collection Box. Call to see if they will accept your medications.

Law Enforcement (Sheriffs and Police) are being encouraged to have a Drug Collection Box in their stations to accept unwanted medications. Check with your local Law Enforcement to see if they will be hosting a collection box.
