The purpose of this notice is to announce that the VA Department of Environmental Quality and VA Marine Resources Commission received a Joint Permit Application from Greensville County to expand an existing public water supply system through construction of a pumped storage reservoir and installation of an intake structure on the Nottoway River in Greensville County, Virginia. The proposed reservoir site is located on Wyatt's Mill Road, approximately 1.65 miles from its intersection with Allen Road. The proposed intake is located on the Nottoway River, approximately 3,000 linear feet upstream of River Road (Route 630). The applicant proposes a transfer of a daily maximum of 12 million gallons per day (mgd) from the Nottoway River to the proposed reservoir and to withdraw a daily average of 5.01 mgd from the proposed reservoir. The intake on the Nottoway River is also proposed to be restricted by limiting the volume of water withdrawn to no more than 10 percent of the stream flow. Construction of the proposed reservoir and associated infrastructure would involve permanent impacts to 6.32 acres of palustrine forested wetlands and 60 linear feet (0.03 acre) along the Nottoway River and temporary impacts to 0.29 acre of palustrine emergent wetland. Permanent wetland impacts are proposed to be compensated through the purchase 12.64 wetland credits from an approved wetland mitigation bank.
