

Public Notice – Environmental Permit

PURPOSE OF NOTICE: To seek public comment on a draft permit from the Department of Environmental Quality that will allow the filling of 0.256 acres of wetland and 3943 linear feet of stream associated with Tapped Branch in Boydton, Mecklenburg County, Virginia.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: For 30 days, starting from the day after the notice is in the newspaper.

PERMIT NAME: Virginia Water Protection Permit issued by DEQ, under the authority of the State Water Control Board

APPLICANT NAME, ADDRESS AND PERMIT NUMBER: Mecklenburg County; PO. Box 307, Boydton Virginia; 14-0359

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Mecklenburg County has applied for a new permit for the Mecklenburg County Industrial Park expansion near the intersection of Routes 58 and 92. The permit will allow the applicant to fill wetlands and streams. The proposed activity would affect 0.256 acres of wetlands and 3943 linear feet of streams. The activity proposed in the permit will affect portions of Tapped Branch in the Roanoke watershed. A watershed is the land area drained by a river and its incoming streams. To compensate for the affected area, the applicant will compensate with credits from the Virginia Aquatic Resources Trust Fund or a wetland mitigation bank serving this area. DEQ's preliminary decision is to approve the permit.

HOW TO COMMENT AND/OR REQUEST A PUBLIC HEARING: DEQ accepts comments and requests for public hearing by e-mail, fax or postal mail. All comments and requests must be in writing and be received by DEQ during the comment period. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of the commenter/requester and of all persons represented by the commenter/requester. A request for public hearing must also include: 1) The reason why a public hearing is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. DEQ may hold a public hearing, including another comment period, if public response is significant and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the permit.
