

Public Notice – Environmental Permit

PURPOSE OF NOTICE: To seek public comment on a draft permit from the Department of Environmental Quality that will allow the filling and excavation of surface waters associated with the proposed road improvements of an existing roadway in Loudoun, Virginia.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: For 30 days, starting from the day after the notice is in the newspaper: July 8, 2015 to August 7, 2015 at 5:00 p.m.

PERMIT NAME: Virginia Water Protection Permit issued by DEQ, under the authority of the State Water Control Board

APPLICANT NAME, ADDRESS AND PERMIT NUMBER: Shirley Contracting Company, LLC; 8435 Backlick Rd, Lorton, Virginia 22079; VWPP No. 15-0076

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Shirley Contracting Company, LLC has applied for a new permit for the Route 606 Loudoun County Pkwy/Old Ox Rd Reconstruction Project between Evergreen Mills Rd (Route 621) and Dulles Greenway (Route 267) in Loudoun County, Virginia. The permit will allow the applicant to widen Route 606 Loudoun County Parkway/Old Ox Road from its existing two lanes to a four lane divided roadway. The project will also involve the construction of related stormwater management (SWM) structures to treat and store stormwater originating from the expanded roadway. The proposed activity will affect a total of 6.81 acres of wetlands and 1,650 linear feet of streams, and will allow the dredging of 150 cubic yards of Horsepen Lake. The activity proposed in the permit will affect Horsepen Run, Cabin Branch, and Unnamed Tributaries to Horsepen Run and Cabin Branch in the Broad Run watershed. A watershed is the land area drained by a river and its incoming streams. To compensate for the affected area, the applicant will purchase 7.61 wetland mitigation credits and 1,320 stream compensation credits. DEQ's preliminary decision is to issue the permit.

HOW TO COMMENT AND/OR REQUEST A PUBLIC HEARING: DEQ accepts comments and requests for public hearing by e-mail, fax or postal mail. All comments and requests must be in writing and be received by DEQ during the comment period. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of the commenter/requester and of all persons represented by the commenter/requester. A request for public hearing must also include: 1) The reason why a public hearing is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. A public hearing may be held, including another comment period, if public response is significant, based on individual requests for a public hearing, and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the permit.
