

## Public Notice – Environmental Permit

**PURPOSE OF NOTICE:** To seek public comment on a draft permit from the Department of Environmental Quality that will allow the filling of wetlands in Fairfax County, Virginia.

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** For 30 days, starting from the day after the notice is in the newspaper: **September 2, 2016 to October 3, 2016**

**PERMIT NAME:** Virginia Water Protection Permit issued by DEQ, under the authority of the State Water Control Board

**APPLICANT NAME, ADDRESS AND PERMIT NUMBER:** NVR, Inc.; 11700 Plaza America Drive, Suite 500, Reston, Virginia 22190; VWPP No. 16-0996

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** NVR, Inc. has applied for a new permit for the Woodland Park East project. The project is located in the southwestern quadrant of the intersection between the Dulles Toll Road (Route 267) and Monroe Street (Route 666). The permit will allow the applicant to construct a mixed-used residential and commercial development with associated infrastructure, and a collector road. The proposed activity would affect 2.20 acres of nontidal wetlands. The activity proposed in the permit will affect unnamed tributaries to Horsepen Run and Sugarland Run in the Potomac River watershed. A watershed is the land area drained by a river and its incoming streams. To compensate for the affected area, the applicant would purchase 4.16 wetland credits from a DEQ approved mitigation bank that is authorized to sell credits to the permitted impact site and/or the Virginia Aquatic Resources Trust Fund. DEQ's preliminary decision is to issue the permit.

**HOW TO COMMENT AND/OR REQUEST A PUBLIC HEARING:** DEQ accepts comments and requests for public hearing by e-mail, fax or postal mail. All comments and requests must be in writing and be received by DEQ during the comment period. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of the commenter/requester and of all persons represented by the commenter/requester. A request for public hearing must also include: 1) The reason why a public hearing is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. A public hearing may be held, including another comment period, if public response is significant, based on individual requests for a public hearing, and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the permit.
