

Biosolids Land Application Frequency

If biosolids are applied to a field only once in a three-year period, biosolids may be applied such that the total crop needs for nitrogen is not exceeded during a one-year crop rotation period including the production and harvesting of two crops in succession within a consecutive 12-month growing season.

If biosolids are applied to a field more frequently than once every three years at greater than 50% of the annual agronomic rate for nitrogen, the permit applicant must submit a nutrient management plan that has been approved by the Department of Conservation and Recreation.
