Delist / Use Removal Summary:

DELIST 2012 - PCBs in fish tissue AND fecal coliform - A12E-01-PCB and A25E-03-BAC (CFL 2002 and 2004)

In previous assessments, this 0.32 mile stretch of water was identified as estuarine (part of segment VAN-A25E_OCC05A02). The estuarine segment has been listed with a recreation use impairment due to fecal coliform bacteria exceedances, as well as with a fish consumption use to a Virginia Department of Health PCB fish consumption advisory. In 2012, this specific 0.32 mile stretch of the Occoquan River was reclassified as free-flowing, riverine segment. Since this portion of the Occoquan River is non-tidal and is above the fall line, the previously identified impairments in the estuarine segment do not apply to the free-flowing segment. This newly classified riverine segment (VAN-A25R_OCC01A12) should be delisted for both the recreation and fish consumption uses.

The aquatic life, fish consumption, wildlife, and recreation uses were not assessed.
