

DEQ has selected the Technical Advisory Committees (TACs) and meeting dates for the revision of the Virginia Solid Waste Management Regulations (9 VAC 20-80), Amendments 7. All of the TAC meetings are advertised on the Virginia Town Hall website and open to the public.

Amendment 7 will review the existing Virginia Solid Waste Management Regulations to improve clarity, to reduce complexity and to focus on results oriented requirements. All topics within the existing regulation are open to consideration. The amendment will repeal Chapter 80 and adopt Chapter 81 concurrently. Six TAC meetings are scheduled from 9 am to 3 pm on each of the following days: July 7, and July 21, August 25, and September 29 in the 1st Floor Conference Room of DEQ's Main Street Building in Richmond.
