

## Public Notice – Environmental Permit

**PURPOSE OF NOTICE:** To seek public comment and announce a public hearing and an information briefing on a draft permit from the Department of Environmental Quality to limit air pollution from a facility in Charles City, Virginia.

**PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:** January 31, 2019 to March 20, 2019

**PUBLIC HEARING:** Charles City Co. Government/School Administration Building auditorium, 10900 Courthouse Rd. in Charles City on March 5, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

**INFORMATION BRIEFING:** Same location as above, beginning at 5:30 p.m. (30 mins. prior to hearing)

**PERMIT NAME:** Prevention of Significant Deterioration Permit issued by DEQ, under the authority of the Air Pollution Control Board

**APPLICANT NAME AND REGISTRATION NUMBER:** Balico LLC; 52610

**FACILITY NAME AND ADDRESS:** Balico LLC/Chickahominy Power, 1380 Coppermine Rd. Ste.115, Herndon, VA 20171

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Balico LLC has applied for a permit to build the Chickahominy Power Station. The facility will be classified as a major source of air pollution and will be located on Chambers Rd. (SR 685), 1 km (0.6 mi.) east of the intersection with Roxbury Rd. (SR 106), adjacent to the Chickahominy substation. Air modeling of this facility, with nearby sources of emissions, has shown that the concentrations of all pollutants and averaging periods are below PSD increments and will not contribute to significant deterioration of air quality. The maximum annual emissions of air pollutants from the facility are expected to be as follows:

The air pollution emissions from this facility, as proposed, are not expected to cause injury to or interfere with safety, health, reasonable use of property, visibility, or to impact soils or vegetation.

**HOW TO COMMENT AND/OR REQUEST BOARD CONSIDERATION:** DEQ accepts comments and requests for Board consideration by hand-delivery, e-mail, fax or postal mail. All comments and requests must be in writing and be received by DEQ during the comment period. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of the commenter/requester and of all persons represented by the commenter/requester. A request for Board consideration must also include: 1) The reason why Board consideration is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. Board consideration may be granted if public response is significant, based on individual requests for Board consideration, and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the permit.
