
Dear Mr. Laskowski:

In order to provide for more effective management of environmental resources in the Commonwealth, the Department of Air Pollution Control, the Department of Waste Management, the State Water Control Board, and the Council on the Environment were consolidated into the Department of Environmental Quality on April 1, 1993. As you know, the Clean Air Act ("the Act") allows the Governor of Virginia to delegate State environmental agency officials with the authority to formally submit to EPA various programs or program revisions required under the Act. Such programs include:

1. State Implementation Plan (SIP) revisions (40 CFR part 52)
2. Section 111(d)/129 plans and plan revisions for designated noncriteria pollutants and facilities. (40 CFR part 62)
3. State Operating Permit Programs (40 CFR part 70)

In order to update our records, I am asking that you provide our office with the current list of delegated State officials who are authorized to submit the following above-listed actions to EPA. In addition to the names and their titles, please also provide our office with any available documents in your files showing the transfer in the authority delegation from the Governor to the designated State official. I ask that you do this by May 28, 1999.
