

plastics at the
source**

Must Do:

1. No EPS foam (aka Styrofoam)
2. No plastic bags
3. Only reusable tableware for onsite dining
4. Proper recycling practices are followed
5. Straws and disposable utensils for takeout are provided only upon request

do two of these:

- 1.No beverages sold in plastic bottles.
- 2.Discount for customers with reusable cup, etc
- 3.Vegetarian/vegan food options are regularly offered
- 4.All seafood must be sustainable: by Seafood Watch
- 5.Water conservation efforts, such as low-flow faucets
- 6.Energy efficiency efforts such as LED lighting


