Primary Responsibilities

Specific Duties

- In advance of the field day, familiarize yourself with the schedule for the day and the location of the various learning stations.
 - In advance of the field day, familiarize yourself with your school's policies related to first aid, emergency plans or any other risk management issues deemed important by your school system, as well as how you are to handle restroom stops and any behavioral problems.
 - Complete all personal communications and organize your own belongings ahead of time, as it will be difficult to make a phone call, return to the bus, etc.
 - If you are a parent, make sure you interact equally with all of the students assigned to you.
 - Immediately address any behavior that endangers other students or negatively impacts the surroundings.
 - Encourage students to pick up any litter, use trash cans, avoid trampling plants unnecessarily and be good stewards in general.
 - Remind students to wash hands or use sanitizing gel before eating a snack or lunch.
 - Help keep your group of students on schedule.
 - Help keep your assigned students quiet enough to hear all instructions and on task while they are completing their field work.
 - Make certain that all equipment is returned to the station's instructor.
 - Other duties as assigned by the teachers coordinating the field day.
 - Be positive and enthusiastic! If conditions are less than desirable your tone will greatly influence your group's mood.
