PURPOSE OF NOTICE: To seek public comment and announce a public hearing on a draft permit from the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for a facility addressing 14 corrective action units and 1 unit currently under active investigation in Radford Virginia.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Radford Army Ammunition Plant applied for a reissued permit on June 22, 2015, for site-wide corrective action. The facility is in Radford, Virginia. The permit will allow the facility to continue site-wide corrective action for identified solid waste management units, hazardous waste management units and areas of concern.

HOW TO COMMENT: DEQ accepts comments by hand-delivery, e-mail, fax or postal mail. All comments must include the name, address and telephone number of the person commenting and be received by DEQ within the comment period. DEQ also accepts written and oral comments at public hearings. To make a statement at a public hearing, write your name on a sign-up sheet available before the meeting. You may sign up only for yourself. The time allowed for each statement is set by the hearing officer. The public may also write to the address below to be added to the facility mailing list. The public may review the draft permit, fact sheet, and application at the DEQ, Blue Ridge Regional Office at 3019 Peters Creek Road, Roanoke, Virginia, 24019 every work day by appointment.
