



New for 2020 Streamlined SWM/ESC Blended Learning Strategy

Overwhelming feedback from attendees in DEQ certification courses has been to reduce content overlap and create more hands-on activities. Responding to this feedback, DEQ will be implementing a blended learning model starting in 2020.

What is a blended learning model?

It is a blend of online learning and traditional classroom-based training

What does this mean for SWM/ESC course enrollment?

For 2020 classes, individuals needing to attend stormwater or erosion certification courses must enroll in a curriculum. This curriculum will include online prerequisite training that must be completed before enrolling in classroom courses.

In 2020, there will only be one online prerequisite (Module 1 - Training & Certification), but we will be expanding online content in 2021.

Starting in 2020, you must enroll in the appropriate certification curriculum.

What's the process for completing the blended learning curriculum?

1. After requesting access to a curriculum, launch and complete online training.
2. After completing prerequisite online training, the system will allow you to enroll in a classroom course.
3. Once you have attended the classroom course, you will receive a curriculum completion certificate (emailed to you and posted to your ELMS transcript). You must bring this certificate with you to sit for an exam.
