

Current MVP Right-of-Way Stabilization

- Majority of ROW is temporarily stabilized
- Stabilization methods include:
 - Temporary Seeding/Vegetation
 - Erosion Control Blanket
 - Straw Mulch
 - Bonded Fiber Matrix (Earthguard)
- Stabilization maintenance and re-application is performed as needed
