Virginia Green Travel Star Award Winners Recognized at 1st Annual Virginia Green Conference

The 1st annual Virginia Green Conference & Awards Celebration was held at the Virginia Aquarium & Marine Research Center in Virginia Beach on December 3 & 4, 2013. Virginia Green recognized 14 program partners in 11 different categories who received the **Virginia Green Travel Star Award**. The program also recognized 8 additional partners who received *Virginia Green Travel Leader Awards*.

Virginia Green is Virginia's voluntary program to encourage green practices in the state's tourism industry. The program is run through a partnership between the Virginia Tourism Corporation, the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality, and the Virginia Hospitality & Travel Association.

The conference featured the award winners and an announcement that Virginia officially considers itself a "green travel destination". More than 1400 tourism operators have now self-certified that they are engaged in a wide range of green practices and commitments. The program also challenges green-minded consumers to *Travel Green* by choosing to support Virginia Green partners, and they can find Virginia Green partners wherever they travel in Virginia.

"Virginia Green partners are having a positive economic impact on Virginia's tourism industry as our partners are realizing significant costs savings and increased business," says Tom Griffin, Virginia Green Coordinator. "Additionally, Virginia Green partners have significantly reduced their annual environmental impacts by more than 20,000 tons of wastes through recycling, 290 million kwh of electricity use, and 850 million gallons of water use. Our award winners have implemented innovative projects and programs that exemplify the voluntary commitments of the program participants."

More than 125 participants attended the program's first annual conference, which also featured technical workshops, a clean-up, a regional tourism partnerships panel, and the awards luncheon. This is the 3rd year of the Virginia Green Travel Star awards.
