In accordance with Part I.B.18 of the referenced permit, Appalachian Power Company (APCo) is providing notice that initial dewatering operations from the Ash Pond 1 closure process are scheduled to begin on July 10, 2017. APCo will discharge treated water in accordance with the effluent limitations put forth in Part I.A.2 of the permit. As also required by Special Condition 18, APCo will submit a subsequent notification to this office within 24 hours of the commencement of dewatering.
