

SaMS WQMR 3rd Meeting: Notes from Other Workgroups & the SAC

Education & Outreach Workgroup (January 24, 2019):

- Other workgroups may benefit from being involved in the pilot outreach campaign or running a concurrent pilot project.
- Recommend coordinating on possible funding opportunities identified by other workgroups and identifying, collectively, possible funding needs prior to reaching out to those identified.

Salt Tracking & Reporting Workgroup (April 16, 2019):

- WQ Monitoring and Research: The minimum piece of information from voluntary tracking and reporting efforts that would benefit the efforts of this workgroup is how much product is used. It was noted by members of the Salt Tracking and Reporting Workgroup that reporting product use by watershed will be a very difficult challenge and is viewed as currently unrealistic.

Stakeholder Advisory Committee (May 29, 2019):

- Arlington County may be a good laboratory for a pilot due to the nature of their salt use data.
- When addressing the pilot proposals in the SaMS document, address it with language that avoids the implication that it is required or being conducted by a known entity. For example, address the pilot by stating recommendations as “If the pilot is conducted...”
