



### *Calling all South Fork Rivanna River Watershed Residents:*

The South Fork Rivanna River watershed includes all of the land area that drains to the river and its tributaries when it rains. Monitoring of aquatic insects that live on the stream bottom has shown that *something is bugging the bugs* in the South Fork Rivanna River and several of its tributaries! These aquatic insects act as a barometer of stream health, warning us of potential pollutants that may be entering our waterways. Input from local residents is needed in order to figure out what pollutant(s) are negatively impacting stream health and what the best ways are to address this problem in the watershed. In the coming months, The Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) and partners will be working closely with interested residents to develop a clean up plan for the watershed. This meeting will serve as the first in a series of opportunities for residents to contribute to the planning process.
