

Public Notice – Environmental Permit

PURPOSE OF NOTICE: This is a re-advertisement to seek public comment and announce a public hearing and information briefing on a draft permit amendment from the Department of Environmental Quality to limit air pollution from a facility in Brunswick County.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: October 7, 2020 to November 30, 2020

PUBLIC HEARING: GoToWebinar on Tuesday, November 10, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

INFORMATION BRIEFING: GoToWebinar 30 minutes prior to the hearing from 5:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

PERMIT NAME: Significant amendment to a Prevention of Significant Deterioration Permit issued by DEQ, under the authority of the Air Pollution Control Board

APPLICANT NAME AND REGISTRATION NUMBER: Virginia Electric & Power Company, Brunswick County Power Station; 52404

FACILITY ADDRESS: 20100 Governor Harrison Parkway, Freeman, VA 23856

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Virginia Electric & Power Company has applied for a significant permit amendment for the Brunswick County Power Station. The facility is classified as a major source of air pollution. The applicant is proposing to include alternative operating scenarios for the turbines during maintenance activities and to add alternative daily emission limits for NOx and CO during those activities. The permit will limit the duration and frequency of each maintenance activity. There will be no increase in the annual potential to emit of air pollutants.

HOW TO COMMENT AND/OR REQUEST BOARD CONSIDERATION: DEQ accepts comments and requests for Board consideration by hand-delivery, e-mail, fax or postal mail. Written comments and requests must be received by DEQ by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the comment period if submitted by hand-delivery or postal mail and by 11:59 p.m. if submitted by fax or email. Submittals must include the names, mailing addresses and telephone numbers of the commenter/requester and of all persons represented by the commenter/requester. Oral comments and requests will be accepted during the public hearing. A request for Board consideration must also include: 1) The reason why Board consideration is requested. 2) A brief, informal statement regarding the nature and extent of the interest of the requester or of those represented by the requestor, including how and to what extent such interest would be directly and adversely affected by the permit. 3) Specific references, where possible, to terms and conditions of the permit with suggested revisions. Board consideration may be granted if public response is significant, based on individual requests for Board consideration, and there are substantial, disputed issues relevant to the permit.
